DESCRIPTION OF THE FY 2011-2012 SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT

The FY 2011-2012 Substantial Amendment is required under Federal regulations at 24 CFR Part 91, as amended by the new Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Interim Rule. For FY 2011-2012 the City received two ESG allocations, the first in the amount of \$97,703 and the second in the amount of \$54,958. To receive funds from the second allocation, the City must prepare, and obtain HUD approval of a substantial amendment to its FY 2011-2012 Annual Action Plan outlining proposed activities for funding.

It is proposed that the second allocation of \$54,958 be used as follows:

- \$27,479 Homeless Management Information Systems
- \$27,479 Rapid Re-Housing
