### **Demolition of City owned Properties and Live Fire Training Exercise**

**2-11-13**

Demolition activities will be commencing on City of Inglewood owned properties located on the 3800 and 3900 block of 102<sup>nd</sup> street, the Southwest corner of Century Blvd and Prairie Avenue, and two single family units on 10220 and 10310 S. Prairie Avenue. Activities will commence on February 18, 2013 and will be completed in approximately two to three months.

During the Demolition members of the Los Angeles County Fire Department will participate in a state certified fire training control course. Over 100 fire fighters will receive training in how to work safely in a burning building. This training will occur during the same time period as the demolition, but will start after the demolition activity has already commenced. The City of Inglewood and the Los Angeles County Fire Department are working cooperatively to provide this fire training opportunity for the fire service personnel. The City of Inglewood Police Department SWAT Team may also conduct training activities. The demolition contractor will commence the activities by removing Asbestos from the buildings; the Fire department will follow conducting their controlled fire training exercise; the demolition company will then conclude by hauling away any part of the building and grade the site. Fencing will be placed around the sites by a separate contractor.

The live fire training will produce visible smoke from time to time. If you see smoke or fire in this area and there are no emergency crews present, then call 911 immediately.

This is a rare opportunity for our firefighters to obtain this type of training and we ask for your support and patience during this valuable exercise. The public is welcome to come and watch the living fire training sites. We ask that viewers follow the directions of the fire fighters on site. The training dates will vary, but will begin by end of February or beginning of March 2013.
